JOB DESCRIPTION

Job title: Pastoral Worker

Reports to: The Reverend of WCCC

Hours: 36 Hours per week

Salary: £23,000 annually

Term: 2 years

Probation period: 6 months

Holiday Entitlement: 28 days plus bank holiday

The Pastoral Worker is the person guiding the direction of the church to carry out Jesus Christ's Evangelical Command. He/she is required to work as a team with the Reverends and Church Leaders.

The Pastoral Worker's duties shall include but not limited to:

- 1. Acting as custodian of the Faith;
- 2. Preaching and teaching of God's Words;
- 3. Providing pastoral care for meeting the needs (to the needs) of the church members especially youth members and youth congregation;
- 4. Providing lead and supports to the Youth Ministry Program and encouraging their spiritual growth in Christ;
- 5. Assisting and promoting the church in the following areas: worships, outreach, fellowships, trainings and serving the community;
- 6. Undertaking any other task that may be reasonably requested of the post.

It should be noted that this is not an exhaustive list of duties and responsibilities, and the post holder may be required to undertake other tasks which fall within the jurisdiction of the job, in discussion with the Church Leaders Group and the Reverends.

The post holder is expected to work closely with Church Leaders Group and the Reverends of Wirral Chinese Christian Church, in particular adhering to confidentiality at all times in relation to information accessed through role involvement.
